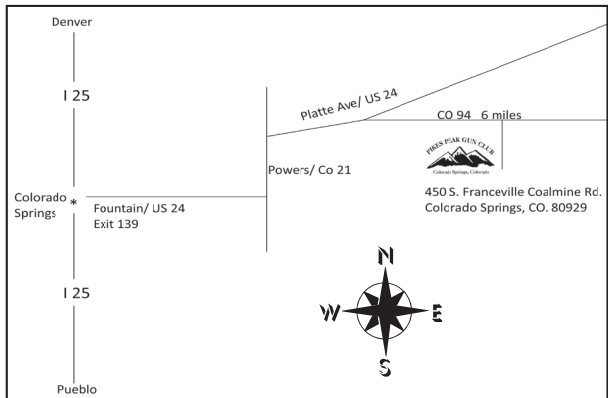

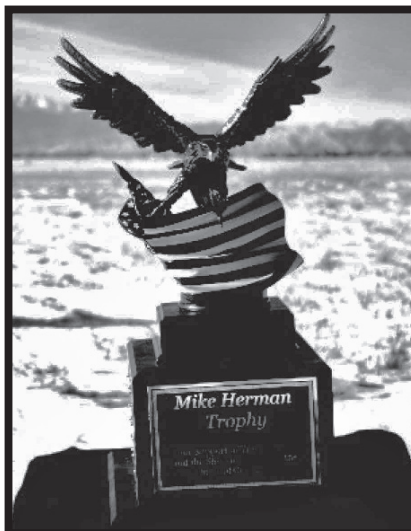

The criteria for election as a State Delegate or Alternate Delegate shall be actual physical residence within the boundaries of the State of Colorado, in receipt of life membership certificate from the A. T. A. and member in good standing of the Colorado State Trapshooting Association. A candidate for election must evidence membership in good standing for at least 5 consecutive years, active participation of at least 500 targets (Singles, Handicap and Doubles combined) in current and previous 4 years with at least 3,000 targets total in current and previous year. Target participation may be waived for shooters with an extensive target history who, because of documented physical problems, are not currently able to participate. **A candidate must have not been suspended for any reason from the ATA.

NOTE: Only those **CSTA Members with a CSTA 2026** membership card and **in possession of a current paid average card** issued by the ATA can vote. (If you plan on voting for your ATA Delegate and ATA Alternate Delegate, please renew your ATA membership prior to the State Shoot). **CSTA members who qualify will be given a ballot at registration.**

GENERAL SHOOT RULES

- Purses and options are not compulsory.
 - Shooting starts promptly at the time indicated and only the starting squads will be called. Please watch the "ON DECK" signs.
 - Classification will be based upon generally accepted ATA procedures and all decisions of the classification committee are final. ***Please have your average card up to date with your averages calculated.***
 - Squad Changes: There is a \$10.00 change fee for any squad changes made after 3:00 pm the previous day.
 - Please attend the meeting for all Colorado Trap Shooters after the 1st 100 singles on Saturday, June 20, 2026 at Noon to elect the ATA Delegate and Alternate Delegate. The Colorado State Team awards will also be presented.
 - Please attend the 2026 Hall of Fame ceremony and induction during Friday Night, June 19th.
 - ALL EVENTS WILL BE SHOT 5 TARGETS PER POST, 50 PER TRAP (Shoot management reserves the right to modify this format.)
 - Ties for events 1, 3, 4 & 6 (Singles & Doubles) will be carried over to the next like event.
 - Handicap ties will be determined by CSTA officials at the end of each day of shooting. If you do not report for shootoffs within the allotted time, you will forfeit. No exceptions to this rule. NO CARRY OVERS!
 - The CSTA reserves the right to alter or modify the program and to reject anyone who, in our opinion is detrimental to the shoot.
 - It is the responsibility of money winners to report their winning to the IRS. Provide your SSN to the cashier during registration to expedite any payoffs you may have coming.
 - Board of Directors meeting: Friday June 16, 2026 - 6:30pm at PPGC Clubhouse
 - Practice Traps will be open & available @ 7:30am daily. Practice rounds will be \$7.00 per 25 targets. Traps available will be posted near bank assignments along with announced. NOTE: During all CHAMPIONSHIP events practice fields will be limited to UPPER Fields up until first flight of shooters due to all 14 fields will be used during these events. PPGC Trap Committee will modify/designate practice fields for the betterment of the shoot at their discretion.
 - Added money is open to all shooters entered in the event.
 - Entrants for husband/wife (Domestic Partners) or two in a family (immediate family such as parent or siblings) in Event 8 must declare prior to the start of the event. You can win only one category.
- (1) It is the responsibility of all special category shooters to ensure they are placed in the correct category at the time they are classified/handicapped. If your special category does not appear on the bulletin sheet, report the omission at the cashier's.
 - (2) **Class Advance:** High Score in each class in Events 3 & 4 will be advanced for all like events. Class advancements will apply independently to in-state and out-of-state classes. PAID OPTIONS FOLLOW SHOOTER TO ADVANCED CLASS.
 - (3) **100 or 200 Straight Pins:** Shooters breaking 100 or 200 straight without carryover will be awarded a 100 or 200 straight pin. Only one such pin will be awarded to any one individual.
 - (4) There will be no co-winners/champions. Ties must be settled for trophies purposes and All American Points.
 - (5) **Credit cards** accepted with a 3% charge for all **targets, options and purses** (Visa, MasterCard, Amex, Discover)



GENERAL INFORMATION (CONT.)

SPECIAL CATEGORY SHOOTERS

All Lady I, Lady II, Sub-Juniors, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub Veteran, Veterans, and Senior-Vets must declare their special category at the time of classification in any registered tournament if they wish to compete as a category shooter. Without such declaration, the contestant will not be allowed to compete for the applicable category trophy. No contestant will be allowed to declare or change a special declaration after firing his/her first shot. The only exception to this rule will be to correct an ATA classification error. The following rules apply to shooters who have declared a special category. At all tournaments where All American points will be awarded in any event, shooters may declare only one (1) category (i.e. Lady I, Lady II, Sub-Junior, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub-Veteran, Veteran, or Senior Veteran) Note: Chair shooters are exempt from this rule.

1. A female shooter, who has not reached her 55th Birthday, may declare Lady I.
2. A female shooter, who had reached her 55th Birthday, may declare Lady II.
3. A shooter who has not reached his/her 15th Birthday, may declare Sub-Junior.
4. A shooter who is 15 but has not reached his/her 18th Birthday may declare as Junior.
5. A shooter who is 18 but has not reached his/her 23rd Birthday may declare as Junior Gold.
6. A shooter who is 55 but not reached his/her 65th Birthday may declare as a Sub-Veteran.
7. A shooter who is 65 but not reached his/her 70th Birthday may declare as a Veteran.
8. A shooter who is 70 years of age and older may declare as a Senior Veteran.
9. Age based categories are established on the Birthday of the shooter. For purposes of determining age category for HOA and HAA awards the category declared by the participant of the first day he/she shoots shall be used.
10. Shooters who become eligible for new age based categories during the target year may elect to continue to compete in the previous category for the remainder of that target year. (For example a shooter reaching age 70 may elect to continue to shoot as a Veteran for the remainder of the current target year.) However, once a shooter has elected to move to the new category that decision is irrevocable and he/she may not again declare eligibility for the previous category. Junior shooters reaching the age of 18 may continue to declare Junior category for the remainder of the current target year. Note: Age based special category shooters that are in contention for or desire to achieve All-American Team recognition should review the All-American Team policy in the ATA Rule Book. When there is no Sub-Junior trophy Sub-Juniors will be included in the Junior category. Senior Veterans will be included in the Veteran category when there is no Senior Veteran trophy.

PETS: Shooters are required to have their pets leashed at all times while on the grounds. It is also mandatory that you clean up after your pet. Owners will be held liable/responsible for their animals.

ATVs AND GOLF CARTS: Use of personal ATVs and golf carts is allowed. Owner must have liability insurance.

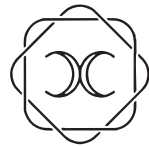

CLASSIFICATION

- Shooters with less than 500 singles or doubles targets in the current target year will be advanced 1 class or more based on their ATA history and known ability.
- Shooters with less than 500 handicap targets in the current target year will be classified at a minimum of 25 yards or higher if their assigned ATA yardage is longer than 25 yards.
- Penalty classification shall be waived for Senior Veteran and Lady II shooters.

The Handicap Committee reserves the right to reclassify any shooter at any time during the shoot.

The A.T.A. rules will govern all points that are not otherwise provided. If you win your class or any event or earn yardage in any handicap, it is your responsibility to report such change to the Committee.

Appropriate hearing and eye protection will be worn by all personnel on the firing line; this includes employees who perform duties on or near the trap field.

Congratulations to Colorado State Trap Shooting Association's 2026 Hall of Fame Inductee.

Scott Obenchain

Scott Obenchain was born in Sterling, Colorado on June 19, 1970 and is the only child/son to Bill and Carol Obenchain. He spent his childhood growing up in Cheyenne Wyoming and Englewood Colorado.

Scott began his shooting career when he was 8 years old. He and his father would attend fun shoots to prepare for the goose and pheasant season. While living in Cheyenne they would mainly go to Galeton in Northern Colorado because they were tired of the Wyoming winds.

At 10, Scott took a semi-hiatus from shooting minus a fun shoot here and there to chase his dreams in motocross. He spent his teens chasing this dream. At 13 years old he earned 5th place in the Mini Expert Class and at 17 he placed 7th in the Open 500 Class. He continued professional racing until he was 18. During this time is when he earned the nickname "Mr. Pink". It was in 1985 when a motocross apparel company came out with pink gear for men. His parents thought it would be a great idea to get him this gear so they could easily identify him on the race track. David Newell's wife embroidered "Mr. Pink" on the bum of his pants and it has stuck to him ever since.

Scott graduated high school in 1988 from Randall Moore High School in Denver, Colorado and soon after moved to Arizona where he went to work with his father in the Heavy Civil Construction Industry. Soon thereafter, Scott welcomed his son Michael and began focusing on his family and his career. During this time Scott did a lot of traveling for his company, living in various places such as: Arizona, Texas, California and New Mexico. This remained his focus until he returned to fun shoots in the early 2000's.

Towards the end of 2004, Scott joined the Amateur Trapshooting Association (ATA), and entered his first competition at Colorado Clays in Brighton, Colorado shooting a Beretta that he still has today. He shot a 98 in singles, 98 in handicap, and 74 in doubles. He won his very first Calcutta and was instantly hooked. In 2008, Scott invested in his current Perrazzi and in September of that year shot his first 100 from the 27 yard line. The same day he did it again for 200/200 in handicap at Colorado Clays. Trapshooting and being involved with ATA and all the amazing people has become such a large part of Scott's life that in 2023 he married his long time sweetheart Anne at the All American Grand in front of the grandstands just before his 1st Blue vs Gray Shootout.

Scott has been extremely active in the ATA since becoming a member. He was the Colorado State Delegate from 2008 to 2010 and is currently the Alternate Colorado State Delegate since 2024.

Scott's achievements in trapshooting are immense. In short, he has won 17 championships in Colorado and 6 in the Colorado Zone shoots. He has also won 11 in New Mexico, 13 in Wyoming, 3 in Utah, and 4 in Nevada for a total of 30 out-of-state championships. Satellite Grands, he has won Singles twice, Handicap once, and HAA once. Scott's most notable Grand trophies include 2020 Champion of Champions winner and runner up in two consecutive years. Most recently, he placed third in the ATA World Clay Target Championship (2025). Overall, Scott has won 42 trophies at the Grand American in his 14 years of attendance.
